We are also looking forward to having our Dads come in for breakfast on Monday 2nd September.
























Dear Families,

Please note:


- Responses are kept anonymous and confidential.



Students from Prep to year 6 will accompany the band as they perform their own brand of homegrown banjo driven ballads and toe tapping grooves for all ages.


